Local rules

- In the interests of safety and enjoyment please respect other users of the course.
- 2. Pace of play: You must adhere to the stated times.
- Trolleys and buggies must be kept off tees and outside greenside bunkers.
- 4. Each player must have their own golf clubs.
- If a match loses more than one clear hole to the match in front it must allow the match behind to play through.
- 6. Players should give way to green keepers.
- 7. Stones may be removed from bunkers without penalty.
- 8. The pond on the 13th hole is a 'water hazard'.
- Immovable obstructions (Rule 24-2): Hydrant covers, sprinkler heads, ball washers, seats, dustbins and tee signs.
- 10. Rabbit and bird scrapes and molehills (Rule 25-1)
- 11. Staked trees: Relief must be taken from all staked trees. The ball must be lifted (without penalty), dropped at the nearest point of relief, no nearer the hole.
- 12. Out of bounds:
- a) Over the boundary fence on the LEFT of 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 8th, 15th, 16th, 17th and 18th holes
- b) Over boundary fence on the RIGHT of the 5th, 7th, 8th, 11th and 12th holes
- c) 10th hole: On pathway, within the confines of the fence and on the cricket pitch as defined by white posts.
- d) 18th Hole: LEFT of the white posts.


DRESS RULES
